



## Quick Facts:

### Who is this suitable for?

Students with experience who want the opportunity to gain a formal qualification without having to complete a recognised training program. Those who join this program can gain recognition for knowledge already gained from other studies, work experience and/or everyday life experience for a full qualification, individual units or a combination of both.

### Entry Requirements

- Certificate II in Animal Studies  
One year full time work placement or equivalent
- Certificate IV in Veterinary Nursing  
Five years full time work placement or equivalent
- Diploma of Veterinary Nursing  
Certificate IV in Veterinary Nursing &  
Ten years full time work placement or equivalent

### Intakes

This program allows entry at any time. Simply request a no-obligation self assessment kit to see whether you have the required skills and knowledge to complete RPL of each unit.

### Course Delivery

- Distance education
- All online, no need for course notes
- Face to face assessments available in your practice
- Online student community and support

### Fees

Price is dependent on prior qualifications, experience and location. Pricing will be given on an individual basis after a panel reviews your self-assessment kit. Each kit costs \$50 and will be deducted from your course cost if you enrol.

Fees are payable by credit card, bank transfer, money order, bank cheque, personal cheque or your clinic can pay via Provet Plus Points. Payment plans can be arranged to meet your personal needs.
