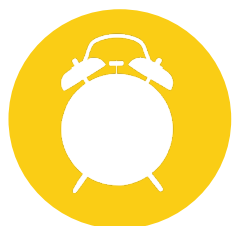

## Entry Requirements

There are no specific pre-requisite knowledge required for entry, however you must:

- Have completed Year 10 or be a mature aged student
- Have a minimum of 8 hours per week of work in a veterinary clinic
- Have an email address, reliable internet access, and an ability to film yourself for assessment purposes
